Great Falls – There’s no better place to stay abreast of what’s going on with grain producers statewide than by reading the Montana Grain Growers Association (MGGA) annual Crop Survey. Already into its 14<sup>th</sup> year, the Montana Crop Survey is posted each Tuesday throughout the growing season on Montana MarketManager Online.

Weekly reports include updates on precipitation, soil moisture conditions, crop growth stage and condition, pest and weed problems and estimated yield potential.
